

RVRC Pre-Trial Supervision Program

Uniquely, RVRC provides day services from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, as well as educational and counseling services from 4:00 pm to 9:00pm. Participants of the shelter are provided breakfast and dinner, thereby negating an individual's need to "hang out" in downtown Wilmington and ultimately decreasing their likelihood of arrest. This design also provides transitioning offenders with an address for probation mandates and provides a therapeutic environment and structure in which to address transitioning obstacles.

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RVRC Pre-Trial Supervision

The pre-trial supervision program is for individuals who are directly referred from the Department of Corrections for intensive case management services while awaiting trial. Assigned case management personnel will meet with pre-trial participants to develop a person-centered plan (PCP) designed to meet the client's individual needs within 72 hours of assignment. Our goal is to monitor, mentor, and coach participants in the program in order to serve them as best as possible and secure the most positive outcomes for each individual.



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Services Offered

- Intense supervision via office visits, home visits, telephone calls, meetings with attorneys, etc.
- Emergency shelter to qualified participants
- Referrals for mental health providers and/or psychiatrists as appropriate
- Medication packaging and distribution by onsite personnel via a partnership with Kirkwood Pharmacy
- Medical care for enrolled participants via onsite nurse practitioner
- Assistance with securing food stamps, general assistance, social security, and other entitlements
- Onsite drug and alcohol education and counseling services via partnership with SODAT
- Onsite GED classes via a Master of Education level staff member
- Resume redevelopment and employment assistance
- Communication with the Department of Corrections, attorneys, & court personnel on an ongoing basis
- Housing assistance through an experienced housing specialist

Participant Assignment System

- Participants are referred to RVRC from the Department of Corrections
- After an intake assessment, participants will be assigned to a personalized track depending on their needs
 - * Assignment to emergency shelter with onsite supervision and intense case management
 - * Assignment to supervision, mental health treatment, and drug & alcohol treatment, with supervision and intense case management
 - * Assignment to supervision and case management only
- All participants will receive direct services at RVRC
