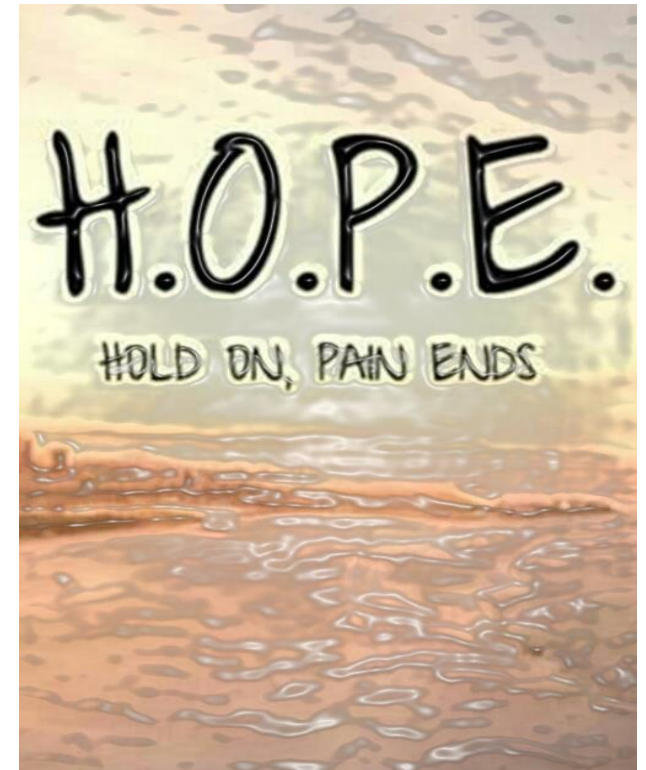

Trauma Informed Care

Trauma Informed Care also emphasizes physical, psychological and emotional safety for both consumers and providers, and helps survivors rebuild a sense of control and empowerment.

Psychiatric Services

These techniques rely mainly on establishing a relationship between the therapist and the patient as a means of developing the patient's insight into the motivation behind his or her behavior. On occasion, drugs may be used, but only in order to make this communication easier.

Crisis Intervention

Offers short term immediate help to individuals who have experienced an event that produces mental, physical, emotional and behavioral distress.
